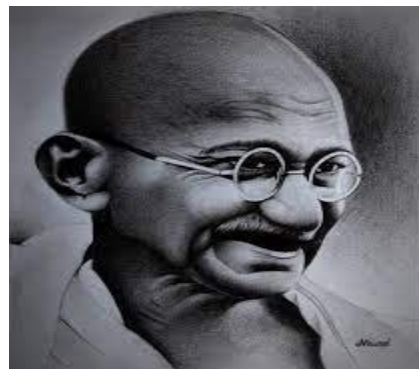
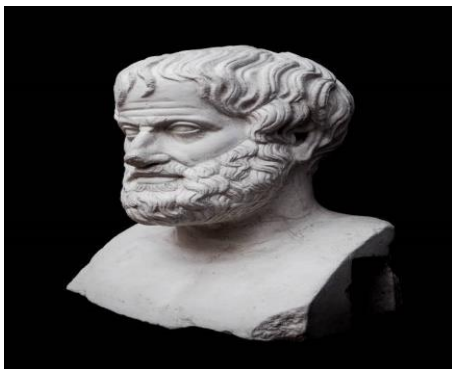

The Department has been following the syllabus approved in the Board of Studies , Sri Krishnadevaraya University, Anantapuramu. The Syllabus is effective under CBCS from the academic year 2020-2021 as per the norms and guidelines issued by AP State Council of Higher Education. Apart from the syllabus, APSCHE included Skill Enhancement Courses (SECs) in Semester V and two Skill Development Courses (SDCs) in Semester I and II. The Government of Andhra Pradesh has introduced Single Major Subject Programme i.e., Four year course in Political Science which is popularly known as B.A. Political Science (Hons) with effect from the academic year 2023-2024. 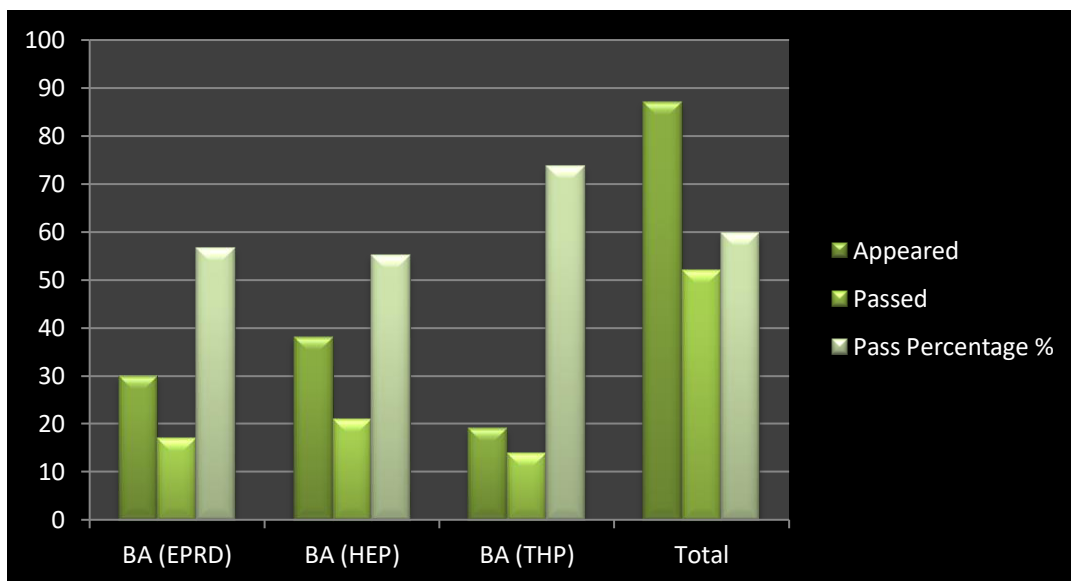

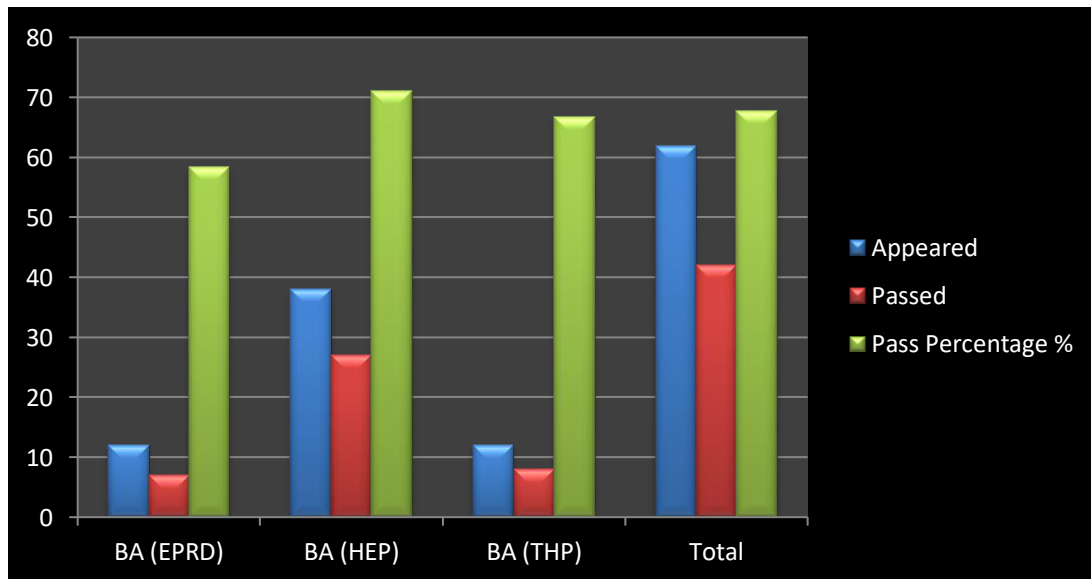
GRAPHICAL PRESENTATION OF RESULT ANALYSIS

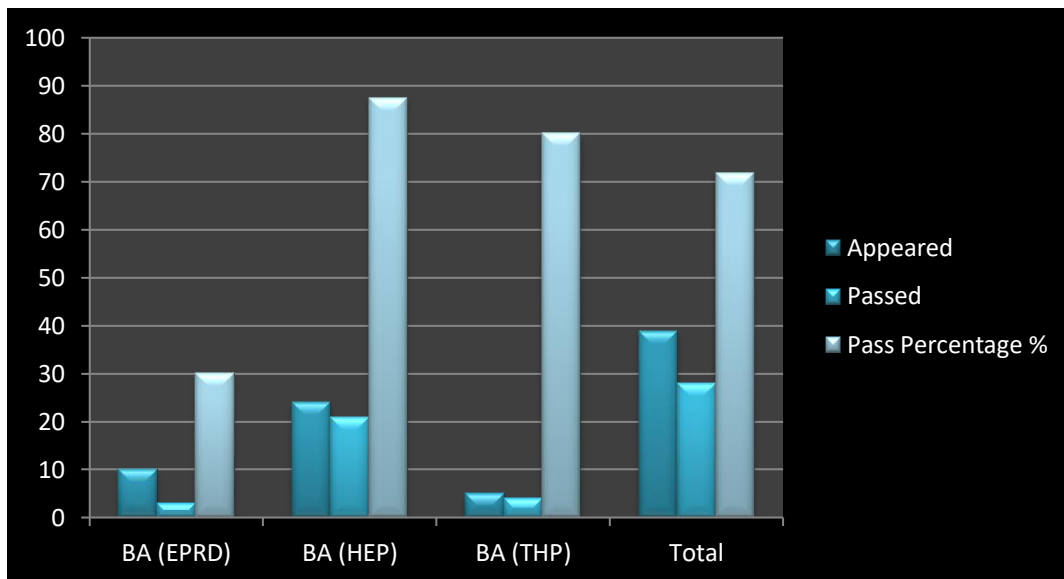
GRAPHICAL PRESENTATION OF RESULT ANALYSIS

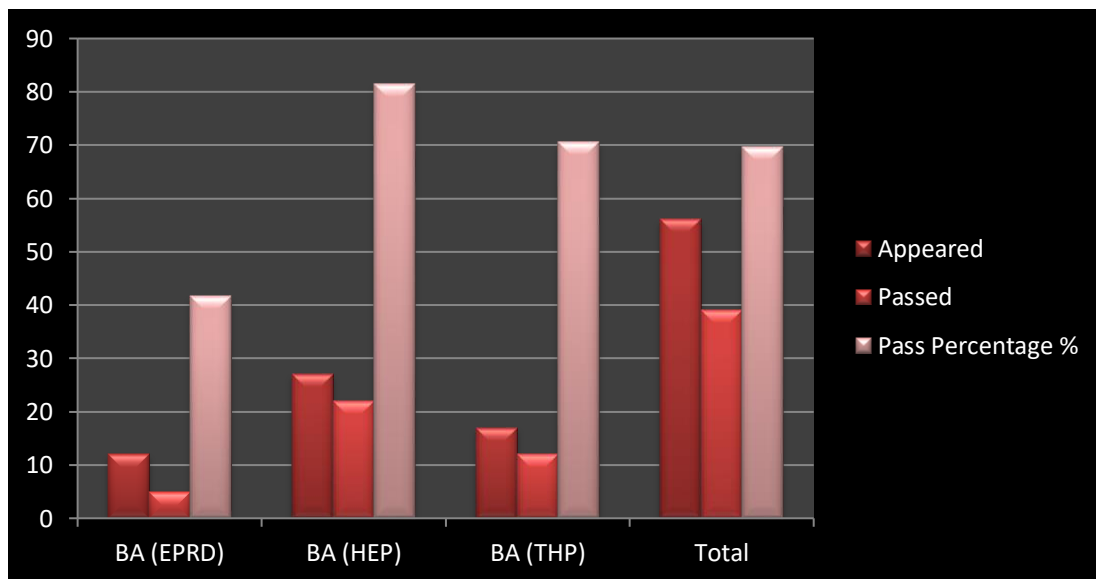
GRAPHICAL PRESENTATION OF RESULT ANALYSIS

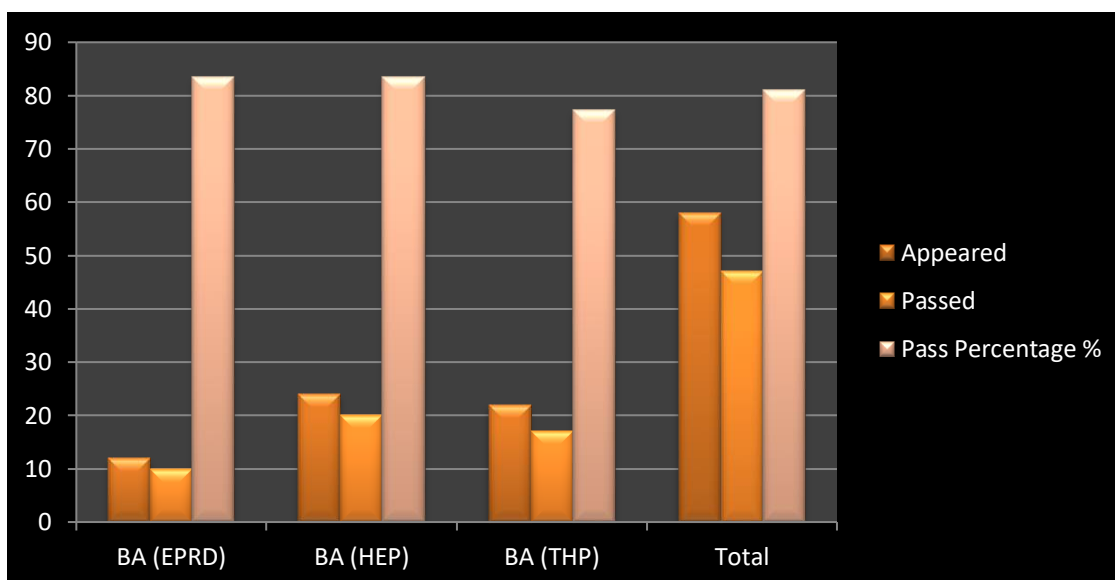
GRAPHICAL PRESENTATION OF RESULT ANALYSIS
